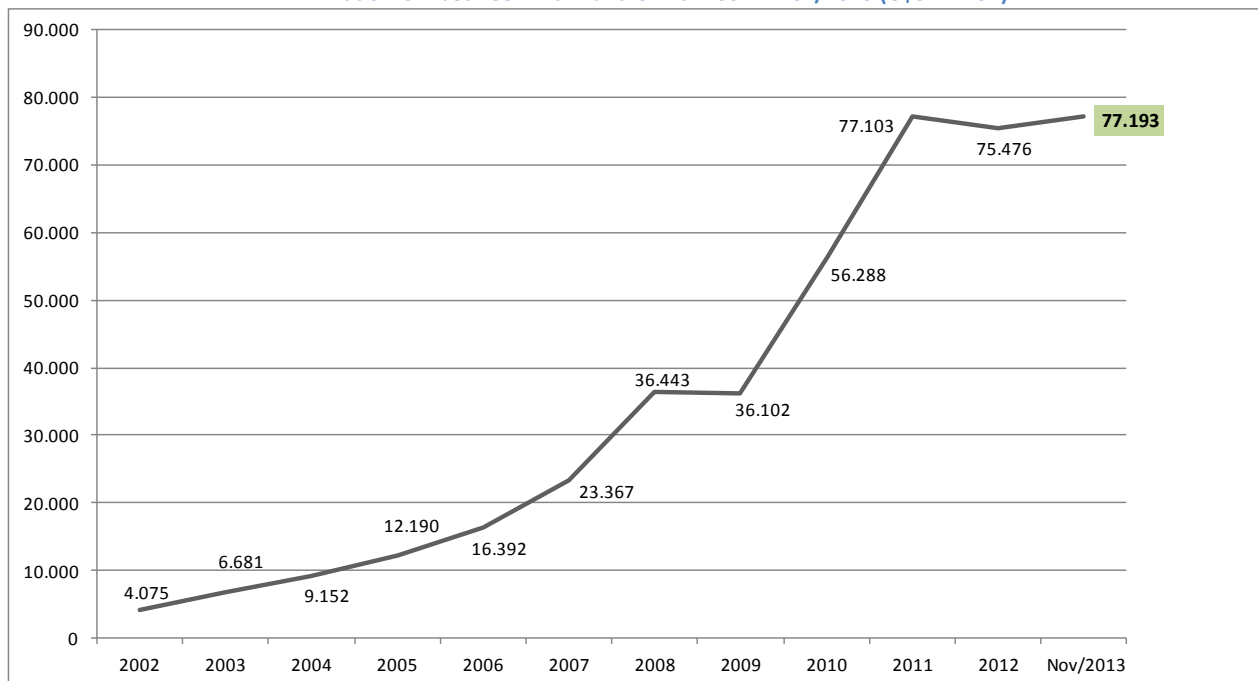
2013 reaches new record in Brazil-China trade flow

According to the Brazilian Ministry of Development, Industry and Foreign Trade (MDIC), it is possible to affirm that the year of 2013 represented a new record in the trade relation between Brazil and China, confirming the estimates elaborated in the last edition of CEBC Alerta.

Until November 2013, the trade flow between both countries reached US\$ 77,193 billion, representing an increase of 0,12% comparing to the US\$ 77,103 billion relative to 2011 (the previous trade exchange record).

In the graphic below it is possible to follow up the path of Brazil-China trade flow, until the last peak registered on November 2013.
